# Wheels to Wellness

TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE

#### What is Wheels to Wellness?

- Wheels to Wellness (W2W) provides Southern Maryland residents with reliable transportation to and from medical appointments.
- Patients 18 and older are driven to and from appointments *free of charge*.
- One support person is allowed to accompany the patient who must also be 18 and older.
- This is a *curb-to-curb* service accommodating patients, including those with walkers, wheelchairs, etc.

#### Who provides the transportation?

- The Arc of Southern Maryland partners with Calvert Health as the W2W transportation provider.
- Patients must be able to get to and from the van without assistance from the driver.

### Where can I go?

• Calvert County residents can be transported to any medical appointment within Calvert County.

#### How do I schedule a ride?

- CalvertHealth's Case Management Department is the point of contact for this program. (contact information)
- The coordinator schedules transportation.
- The Arc of Southern Maryland fulfills the request.



This program may also be used for interim periods while applications are pending for other programs. Please contact the Care Coordinator at your doctors office to see if you qualify.

State Medical Assistance (Medicaid) recipients may qualify for last-resort transportation. Please call your Local Health Department to find out more.
